

AWARD RULES – (2) \$500.00 Jack Powell Scholarship Program

UNITED STEELWORKERS LOCAL 4974

ELIGIBILITY

Any high school student graduating between January 1, 2010 and July 1, 2010, is eligible to compete if they are the son, step-son, daughter, step-daughter or legal ward of a member in good standing of USW, Local 4974. The scholarship is not restricted to any sex, race, religion or political affiliation.

CONDITIONS OF THE AWARD

Arrangements will be made for a one-time payment of the Jack Powell Scholarship Award winner's tuition of \$500.00 after he/she presents evidence that he/she has been accepted as a Freshman student in an Institution accredited by a Regional Association of Colleges, or by a State Department of Education. Winning this scholarship Award, DOES NOT guarantee entrance to a College or University.

The tuition will be paid at the start of the semester to the Educational Institution. The award will be invalid and no payment made if the Scholarship Winner is not in school by December 1, 2010.

There are no restrictions as to the curriculum of the student, except that it is one that will normally lead to a recognized Associate or Bachelor's Degree

If the winner of the award fails to register and be accepted at a college or university, he/she will be disqualified from the Jack Powell Scholarship Program.

DRAWING

Drawing for a Scholarship winner will be held at the Local 4974 Union Meeting on Monday, April 12, 2010, at Ronn Hall.

Five (5) names will be drawn and the first two names drawn will be the winners of the Jack Powell Scholarship Award, providing the students qualify according to the conditions of the award, as outlined above. The other three names will be runners up respectively in the event of a disqualification.

DECISION OF THE COMMITTEE

All matters pertaining to the Jack Powell Scholarship Award will be handled by the Trustees and Financial Secretary of United Steelworkers, Local 4974. The decision of the Jack Powell Scholarship Committee will be FINAL.

The winner of the Award will be notified by mail, and the announcement of the winner will be posted at the Tilden Mine and on the Local 4974 website.
